By car

Take the Ring (RO) around Brussels, in the direction of Charleroi - Namen/Namur. Follow the tunnels under Quatre Bras in Tervuren and under the junction with E411 in Jezus-Eik. Keep following the direction of Waterloo through the Zoniën forest. At the next tunnel, take exit Bosvoorde. Drive under the railway bridge and immediately turn right (Duboislaan). After about 300 metres you'll see on your right a sign 'Instituut voor Natuur- en Bosonderzoek'. Follow the narrow climbing road and after about 100 metres you'll reach the buildings of INBO Groenendaal.

On foot or by bike from Groenendaal station

From Brussels North there is a CR train in the direction of Louvain-la-Neuve that stops in Groenendaal every hour. But be careful: not every train in the direction of Louvain-la-Neuve stops in Groenendaal. Travel time by train is about 25 minutes.

Cross the station square at Groenendaal station and take left on the Groenendaalsesteenweg. At the big junction, walk under the RO and turn left under the railway bridge. Cross the junction to reach the Duboislaan. After about 300 metres you'll see on your right a sign 'Instituut voor Natuur- en Bosonderzoek'. Follow the narrow climbing road and after about 100 metres you'll reach the buildings of INBO Groenendaal – a 15 minute walk from the station.
